



WHAT DOCUMENTS YOU MAY NEED TO MAKE THIS WEDDING OFFICIAL?

The documentation outlined below will be **REQUIRED ON YOUR ARRIVAL IN BARBADOS.**

Please note that only **ORIGINAL DOCUMENTS** are acceptable to the authorities. Copies cannot be used and are **NOT** required by us prior to travel, **UNLESS ** APPLIES - SEE BELOW**

- © **Passport, valid for minimum 6 months.**
- © **Birth Certificate. (Both short and long certificate are acceptable)**
- © **Full address of US Residence of both you and your partner.**
- © **Details of Occupation of both you and your partner.**
- © **If either you or your partner is divorced:** Proof of the Decree Absolute is required.
- © **If either you or your partner is widowed:** The former marriage certificate and death certificate of the spouse is required.
- © **If either you or your partner has changed your name by deed poll:** Proof is required that the procedure was followed and completed.
- © **If either you or your partner will be under 18 years of age on the date of your marriage, and will not be accompanied by a parent or legal guardian:**
An affidavit, granting permission for the wedding to take place, is required from the parent, or legal guardian. This must be prepared and sworn in the US, prior to your date of travel.
- © **If either you or your partner have been adopted:** Adoption papers need to be produced.
- © **Any relevant documentation you hold which is in any language other than English, must be accompanied by a certified translation.**
